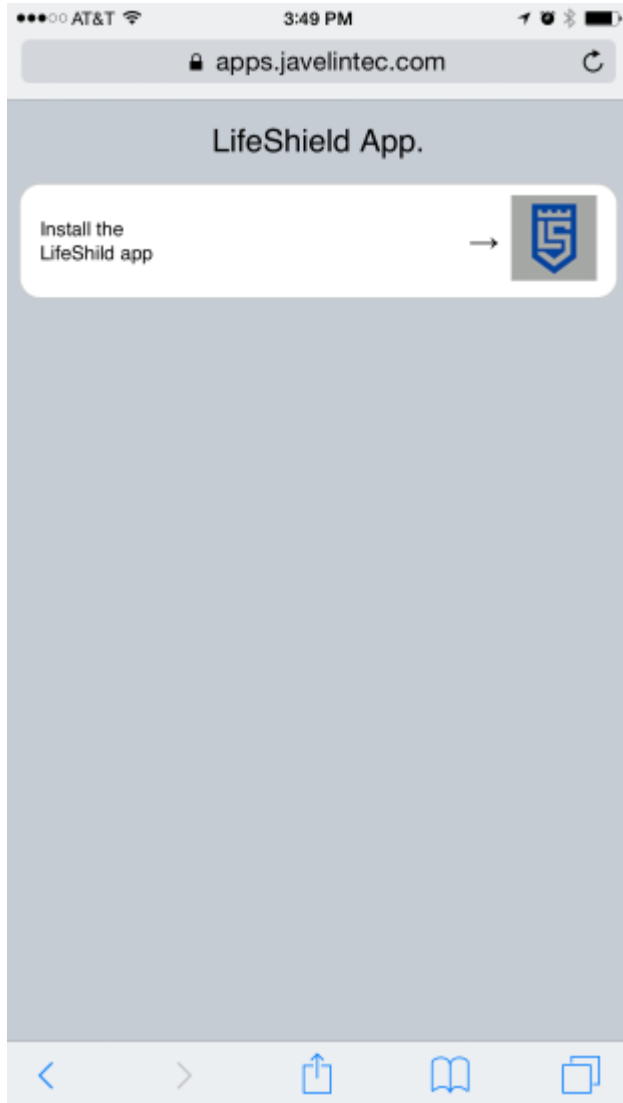
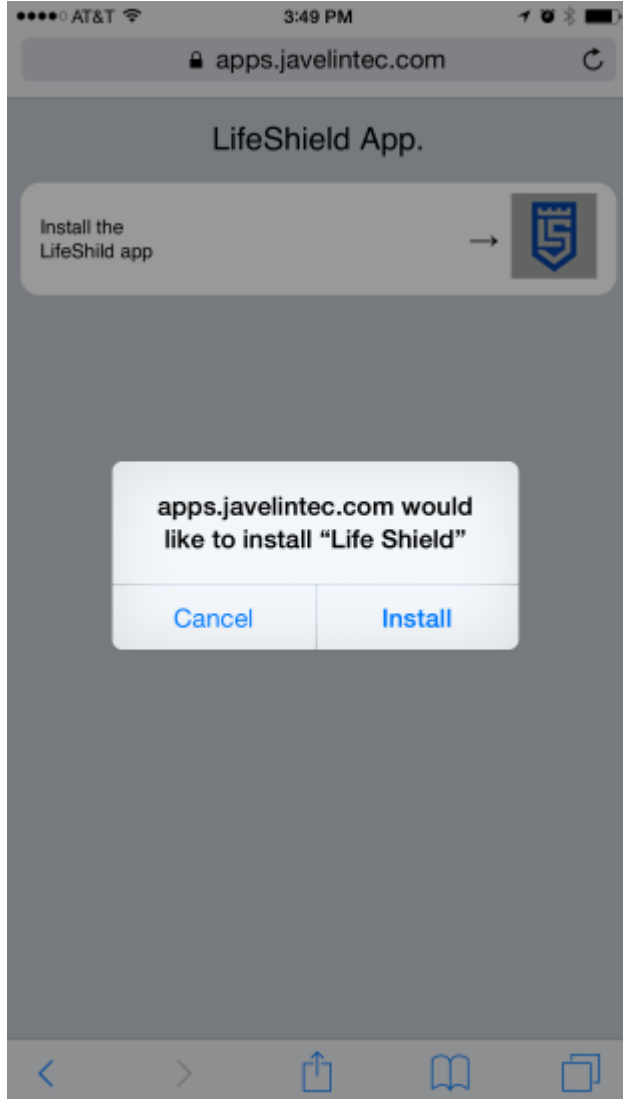


- 1) On your iOS Device, go to <https://apps.javelintec.com/LifeShield> it should look like the screenshot below.



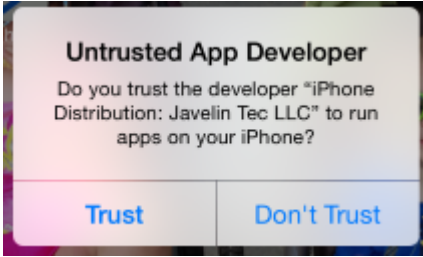
- 2) Press “Life Shield Image on the right,” a pop up will appear like the screenshot below. You will need to press “Install.”



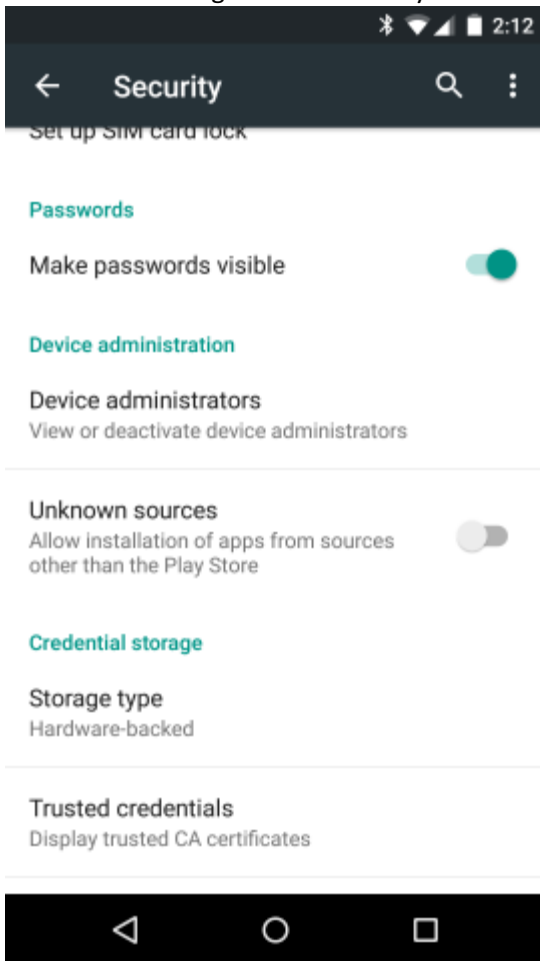
- 3) Next you will press the “Home” button on your device. You should the app installing/installed on your device. The app icon will look like the screenshot below.



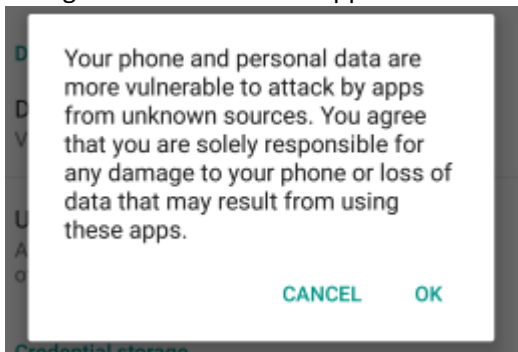
- 4) Next you will press the “LifeShield” app icon to launch the app. You will get a popup like the screenshot below, you will need to press “Trust” in order to run the app. Once you do that the app is ready to run on your iOS device.



- 1) On your Android Device, go into Settings > Security and you will need to look for an option to “Allow installation of apps from sources other than the Play Store” similar to the screenshot below. The settings screen will vary from device to device.



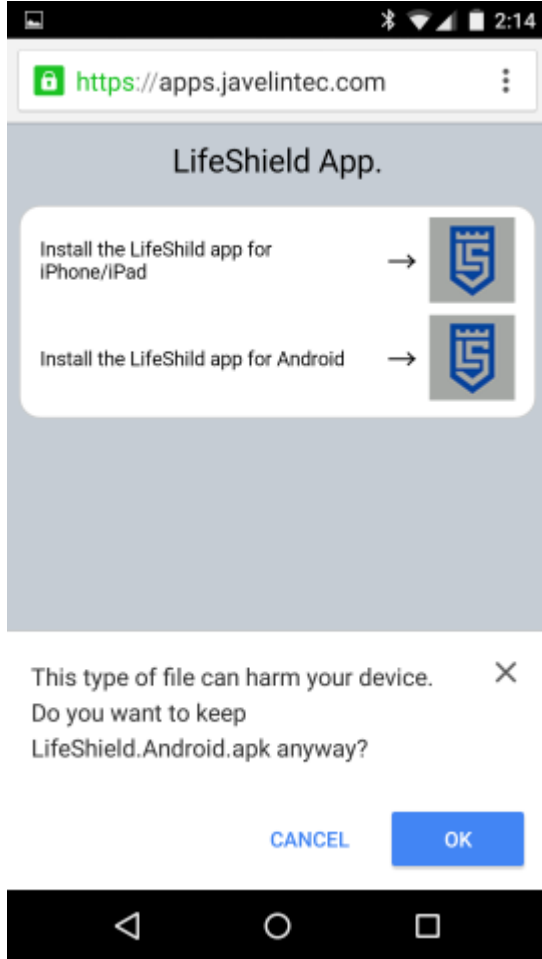
- 2) When you enable it you will see a warning similar to the screenshot below, you will need to press “OK” or “Accept” in order to install the LifeShield App. Once the app is installed you can change it back to disallow apps from other sources.



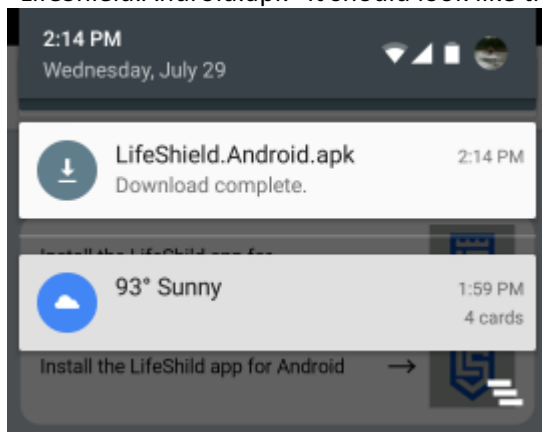
- 3) On your Android Device, go to <https://apps.javelintec.com/LifeShield> it should look like the screenshot below.



- 4) Press “Life Shield Image on the right for Android,” a pop up will appear like the screenshot below. You will need to press “OK.”



- 5) Next you will pull down your notifications menu from the top. You will press on “LifeShield.Android.apk” It should look like the image below.



- 6) Next you should see a screen that ask you if you want to Install the application, press “Install” and wait for it to complete. Once complete you can add the application to one of your app pages or you can just launch it from the applications menu.
